

OSSO Frequently Asked Questions - Parents

When are the games? Saturdays. The U5 to U12 age groups play between 9AM & 4PM. U14 and U16 may play in the evening or on other days.

Where do we play? At the Jackson County Soccer Complex for U5 to U12. U14 & U16 may travel to surrounding communities. The complex is located on Hwy 90 east of Hwy 57.

Where and when are practices held? We leave that up to your coaches. There will be no more than two practices each week, in the evenings. Coaches may hold practice at any available field. Most coaches practice at the Jackson County Soccer Complex. We always appreciate Volunteer Coaches and Assistant Coaches. Please let us know if you would like to apply.

How old do you have to be to play? Children must be between the age of 4 and 15 before July 31 of the current year.

What does OSSO supply? OSSO provides each player with a jersey, shorts, and socks. Parents supply cleats and shin guards. Soccer cleats have no toe cleat. Shin guards are required to be worn at all practices and games.

When is the season? U5-U12 Registration ends September 15. Teams are assigned in October. Our first games will start in late October or early November. The U10/U12 OSSO Tournament will be in late February.

When and Where are games for the Older players? You can register now for the U14 and U16 age groups, but teams may not be set until January. Regular season games for these age groups will start in February. There will be many games in a shorter amount of time. They will play some home games and some away games. They are likely to play a double-header or round robin set on the weekends they play.
